Private Bus (This refers to private bus companies who operate a regular service to Dublin, please consult local information bulletins etc. for information)

Directions to Liberty Hall Theatre

Coming From Heuston Station:

Come out the main door of Heuston station and walk across the road in front of you until you reach the LUAS platform, you are looking for an 'inbound tram (heading towards Connolly Station or The Point)' which will arrive on the platform closest to the door of Heuston station. Take the LUAS as far Abbey Street (5 stops away), get off the tram at Abbey Street and continue walking along the luas line towards the Abbey Theatre / VHI building / Irish Life. Turn right at beresford place and walk towards the river liffey (quays), the next building you meet on the right-hand-side is the main SIPTU building (Libety Hall), take the right turn just on the corner and the entrance to the Theatre is the first right.

Coming From Connolly Station:

Exit Connolly Station via the main exit; go downstairs onto the LUAS platform board a tram for bound for 'Tallaght or Saggart' and get off at Abbey Street (2 stops away). Get off the tram at Abbey Street,), get off the tram at Abbey Street and continue walking along the luas line towards the Abbey Theatre / VHI building / Irish Life. Turn right at beresford place and walk towards the river liffey (quays), the next building you meet on the right-hand-side is the main SIPTU building (Libety Hall), take the right turn just on the corner and the entrance to the Theatre is the first right.

Coming From Busaras:

Exit Busaras via the main entrance, turn immediately right and follow along the outside of the building until to come to 'Store Street' there is a LUAS stop there on store street to the side of Busaras. Take a tram bound for 'Tallaght' to Abby Street (1 stop away). Get get off the tram at Abbey Street continue walking along the luas line towards the Abbey Theatre / VHI building / Irish Life. Turn right at beresford place and walk towards the river liffey (quays), the next building you meet on the right-hand-side is the main SIPTU building

(Liberty Hall), take the right turn just on the corner and the entrance to the Theatre is the first right.

Where to buy LUAS tickets and other information:

All stops have ticket machines that accept coins, notes and credit cards. It is simple to purchase your ticket, just follow the instructions displayed on the machine.

Coming From O'Connell Street:

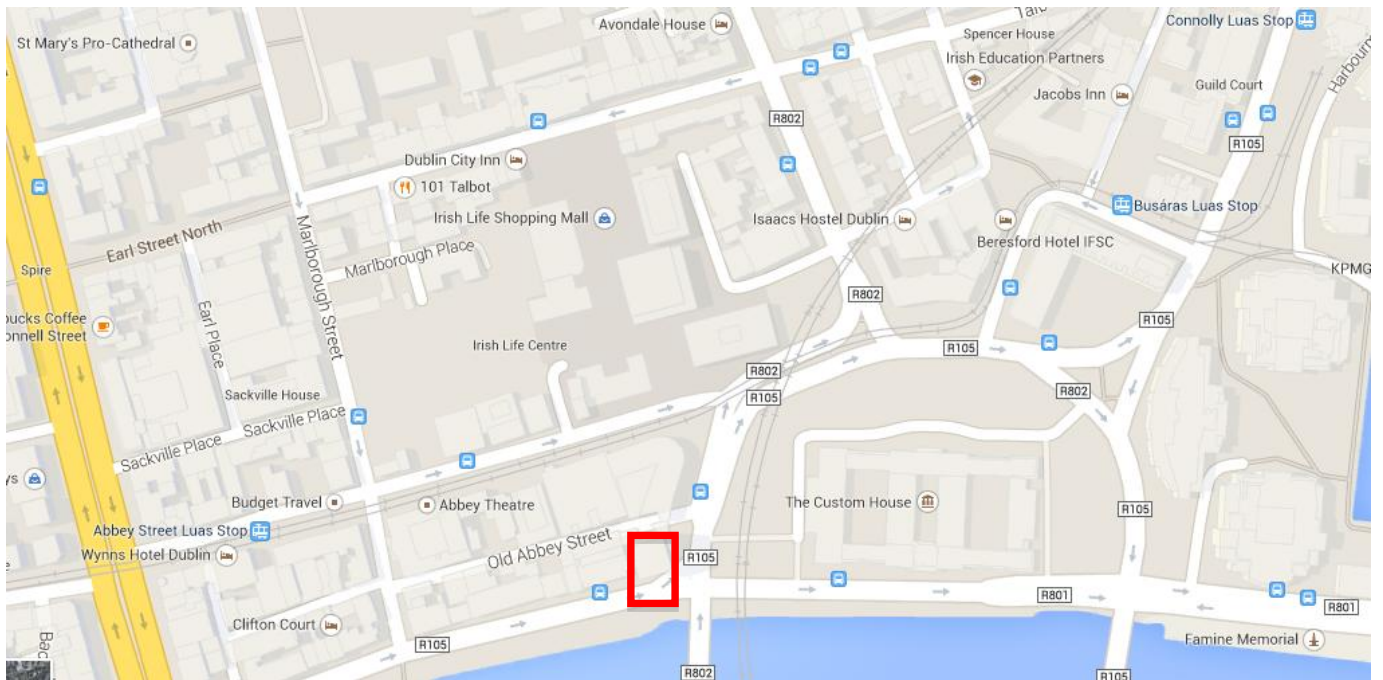
At the Spire in the middle of O'Connell Street, continue to walk southbound (towards river liffey), continue to walk down beside Clerys Department Store, past subway/centra and turn right onto Abbey Street at the Irish Permanent Bank. You see Wynns Hotel and Abbey Street luas stop on the right hand side of the road. Continue towards the luas stop, and continue walking along the luas line towards the Abbey Theatre / VHI building / Irish Life. Turn right at beresford place and walk towards the river liffey (quays), the next building you meet on the right-hand-side is the main SIPTU building (Liberty Hall), take the right turn just on the corner and the entrance to the Theatre is the first right.
